



# IN CASE OF EARTHQUAKE



## BEFORE THE EARTHQUAKE



01

### Ensure your space is safe

Find out where the water and electricity shut-off valves are and how to close them. These systems may be damaged during an earthquake. Avoid placing heavy objects on shelves or unstable furniture. Keep a first aid kit, a flashlight, and a battery-powered radio at home, and ensure that every resident is aware of their location.

02

### Follow the emergency evacuation plan

Follow the instructions of the Emergency and Evacuation Plan to help manage the situation effectively.

03

### Find a safe shelter

If you are indoors, take cover under a table, next to a sturdy wall, or under a load-bearing beam to protect yourself from falling debris. Stay away from furniture, heavy objects, and glass that could break.

04

### Do not use stairs or elevators

Avoid using stairs, as they may be the weakest part of the building. Do not use the elevator, as it might get stuck during the earthquake. Do not run or move around unnecessarily—stay in your designated emergency area to avoid hazards.

05

### If you are in a car or outdoors

If you are driving, do not stop near bridges, tunnels, or beaches, as they may collapse or be hit by a tsunami. If you are outdoors, stay away from buildings and power lines that could fall. Avoid using phones or vehicles to keep emergency lines and roads clear for rescue services.

06

### Check your health condition

Assess your own condition and that of those around you, especially children and vulnerable individuals. Help those in difficulty and provide assistance if needed. Do not attempt to move severely injured people unless necessary, as it may worsen their condition.

07

### Reach a safe area

Carefully exit the building, wearing shoes to avoid injuries from broken glass and debris. Move to an open area away from buildings and other structures that could collapse.



**After a significant tremor, leave the residences and go to the designated gathering points (waiting areas):**

For residents of the 1st lot, the designated area is the gazebo in front of the residences;  
For residents of the 2nd lot, the designated area is in front of the residences, at the end of the parking area near the railing.
